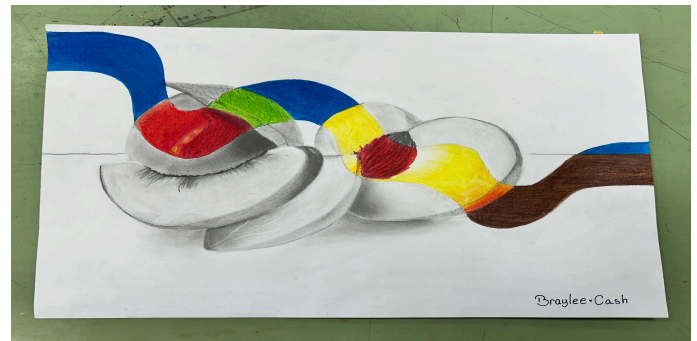


Name: Braylee Cash
